

**Statement of Exemption

Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)
Title I, Part A Supplement, Not Supplant (SNS) Compliance Requirement**

Under ESSA Title I, Part A, the LEA must either demonstrate a valid SNS Methodology that is used to allocate State and Local funds to campuses, or have a Statement of Exemption.

Title I Part Statute:

Section 1118(b)(1)

All LEA shall use Federal funds received under this part only to supplement the funds that would, in the absence of such Federal funds, be made available from State and local sources for the education of students participating in programs assisted under this part, and not to supplant such funds.

Guidance on Exemptions

Based on guidance from the US Department of Education, LEAs that meet one of the situations described in the Statement of Exemption section, below, will not be required to demonstrate a methodology for allocating its State and local funds to its campuses in order to comply with the SNS Methodology requirement for Title I, Part A. The situations described, below, result in Title I neutral situations with regard to campus allocations. Therefore, the SNS requirement at the campus level is met for Title I, Part A purposes, as long as the LEA provides enough State and local resources to its campus(es) to provide a free, public education in the absence of Title I, Part A funds. Title I, Part A funds that are reserved at the LEA level must be used only for Title I, Part A purposes, as indicated in the LEA's approved ESSA Consolidated Federal Grant Application.

Statement of Exemption

The LEA, named above, will not be required to demonstrate a methodology for allocating its State and local funds for the reason indicated, below:

- All of the campuses in the LEA are Title I campuses.
- The LEA has only one campus in each campus category [Elementary, Middle, High School]

Subject: Notification to Parents of Teacher/Paraprofessional Qualifications

Dear Parent:

In accordance with Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)/ PARENTS' RIGHT-TO-KNOW, this is a notification from Springlake-Earth ISD to every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right to request and receive in a timely manner: a) information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers and/or paraprofessionals.

The information regarding the professional qualifications of your student's classroom teachers/paraprofessional shall include the following:

- I. If the teacher has met state certification/qualification criteria for the grade level and subject areas taught
- II. If the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which state certification/qualification criteria are waived;
- III. The teacher is assigned in the field of discipline of the certification;
- IV. Whether the student is provided services by paraprofessionals, and if so, their qualifications [ESSA 1112(e)(1)(A)(i)-(ii)]

In addition to the above information, you will be notified if your student has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who does not meet the applicable state certification requirements at the grade level and subject area in which the teacher has been assigned. [ESSA 1112(e)(1)(B)(ii)]

Teachers may meet this requirement if the district is implementing its approved District Innovation teacher certification policy or if the teacher meets the State Certification assignment rules.

De acuerdo con la ley de todos los estudiantes con éxito (ESSA)/EL DERECHO DE LOS PADRES A SABER, requiere que los padres sean notificados que tienen derecho a solicitar y recibir de manera oportuna: a) información sobre las calificaciones profesionales de los maestros y/o paraprofesionales de su estudiante

La información sobre las calificaciones profesionales de los maestros/paraprofesionales del salón de clases de su estudiante deberá incluir lo siguiente:


- I. Si el maestro ha cumplido con los criterios estatales de certificación/calificación para el nivel de grado y las materias enseñadas
- II. Si el maestro está enseñando bajo estado de emergencia u otro estado provisional a través del cual se renuncia a los criterios de certificación/calificación del estado;
- III. El docente es asignado en el campo de disciplina de la certificación;
- IV. Si el estudiante recibe servicios de paraprofesionales y, de ser así, sus calificaciones [ESSA 1112(e)(1)(A)(i)-(ii)]

Además de la información anterior, se le notificará si a su estudiante será enseñado durante cuatro o más semanas consecutivas por un maestro que no cumple con los requisitos de certificación estatales aplicables en el nivel de grado y la materia en la que se le asignó el maestro. [ESSA 1112(e)(1)(B)(ii)]

Los maestros pueden cumplir con este requisito si el distrito está implementando su política aprobada de certificación de maestros de Innovación del Distrito o si el maestro cumple con las reglas de asignación de Certificación Estatal.
